This is your current ward update for Brunswick and Adelaide, looking back at the month just gone, and offering current crime prevention advice.



Within the month of April:

- Reports of ASB increased to 31 reports.
- There 3 reports of burglaries.
- There were 3 reports of criminal damage.



Patrols:

There were 6 patrols within the month of April. The average patrol time was 43 minutes. Unfortunately, the month had been very busy and there were a number of abstractions which meant officers were not able to be in the area as much.

Specifics:

- 1 arrest for possession of drugs
- 1 arrest for drunk and disorderly
- 4 reports of ASB/drug use in Palmeira Square
- 1 report of drug dealing in Waterloo Street Gardens
- Illicit tobacco seized from a vehicle



Key Priorities:



- To see more patrols in hotspot areas such as the green spaces, Waterloo Street gardens and surrounding roads, and along the general thoroughfare of Western Road.
