Priority 1

Shoplifting

- The team continue to closely monitor shoplifting on the ward. We work in conjunction with the manager at Co-Op regularly to report and investigate incidents of shoplifting and apprehend offenders.
- We continue to regularly attend Co-op and Sainsburys and Shell in a mix of plain clothes and uniformed patrols to disrupt any offences from occurring.
- This period there have been 11 reports of shoplifting made to Police. This is a reduction from 19 during the previous period.







Priority 2

Theft of Pedal Cycle

- During this period there has been 11 reports of theft of pedal cycle. This is one higher from the previous period.
- We expected this figure would again be high due to the summer period and school children being off.
- As a team we have conducted uniformed patrols in the hotspots on the ward over various times.
- PCSO regularly conducts bike marketing events in the ward which are promoted on social media.
- The team conduct CCTV enquiries for all reports to identify offenders.








Priority 3

Theft of/from Motor Vehicle

- Ward Officers continue to collate all information from reports to identify trends and patterns.
- The team regularly complete plain clothed patrols in main hotspots especially at night when most of these incidents occur. When on patrols they conduct stop and searches are completed where grounds exist.
- During this period there has been 5 reports of theft of motor vehicle, and 4 reports of theft from motor vehicle.



Reduce the risk of your vehicle being targeted by thieves by following our advice:

- Check your vehicle is locked and secure every time you leave it. Thieves often look for easy opportunities to steal from vehicles. They will usually try the handles until they get lucky and find one that has been left unlocked.
- Remove all items from view by taking them with you or putting them in the boot out of sight. Thieves will look for any items on display. Things like clothes, documents, or an old bag might not seem like 'valuables' but they could tempt a thief.
- If you have a garage at home use it. If you don't, try to park in a well-lit, open space.
- Try to use public car parks that are part of the police approved 'Park Mark' safer parking scheme.


