Norbiton Ward Panel Meeting:

The Ward Panel Meeting took place on Thursday 10th July 2025 at Queen Mary Hall Cambridge Gardens from 18:30 Hours. Attendees: John Turner(Chairman), Representatives from The Met Police Norbiton Safer Neighborhood Team, Representatives from the Royal Borough of Kingston, A representative from TRICON RA Cambridge Road Estates Residents, Representative from CREST, One Norbiton and Sunflower Streets RA.

A presentation about Violence Against Women and Girls by Kavitha from RBK who led a discussion about the ongoing issue of Domestic Violence and called for a coordinated community response. The White Ribbon day (25th Nov) was singled out as a good opportunity to deliver bystander training so that everyone knows how to respond if a possible incidence is noticed.

Mike spoke about the sad loss of Ed NAYLOR, one of the founding fathers of One Norbiton.

He was always very keen on promoting Neighborhood Watch, which would therefore have made him an enthusiastic supporter of Met Engage, a new system of communication which integrates Neighborhood Watch. All residents are encouraged to join:

The Safer Neighborhood Team Report was presented by Sergeant Jon Edwards. He told participants that the New MPS communication tool "Met Engage "had been launched and was actively being rolled out across Kingston BCU. He called upon all residents to sign up and complete the survey when signing up.

- He mentioned some Resourcing challenges facing the MPS.
- SW units being tasked with additional patrols
- Liaison with other forces ongoing
- Looking at ways Criminal Behavior Orders (CBO's similar to ASB Warning Notices) can be effectively used to identify opportunities to add conditions to deter criminal activity and encourage engagement with support services.
- Crime Statistics show that levels of reported crime has remained even, with no significant spikes. Drug use and drug supply remains the biggest challenge.
- 15 arrests since last meeting. Reporting appears to remain an issue.

Action: The monthly Police Newsletter will have a better font!

- 7 charges for drug related offenses, as well as a number of persons recalled to prison or sent back to court after Failing to Appear.
- The court has extended the Closure Order in place on Cambridge Gardens for a further 3 months from 12:00 Hours on 8/08/2025 to 23:59 Hours on 7/11/2025.
- Joint partnership work is ongoing to tackle the current seasonal issues at Kingston Cemetery.
- Work to achieve Closure Orders in a number of blocks on CRE has begun. We need assistance with obtaining statements from residents to support the applications. Other additional issues and ward panel priorities to be tackled by the SNT include: Anti-social Behavior, Drug dealing and drug use, Speeding on some roads

Graham(resident), asked for police assistance in communicating to the residents of property (81A Bonner Hill Road) about rules outlined by the ICO regarding the positioning of CCTV cameras installed that face Bonner Hill Road and Piper Road. Currently each camera covers a field of vision extending more than 20 meters outside the boundary of this property. More than 20 residents on Piper Road have expressed feelings of intimidation.


