

Brunswick and Adelaide PCSO Monthly Update

Hello everyone! I hope you had a lovely festive period.

This is your current ward update for Brunswick and Adelaide, looking back at the month just gone, and offering current crime prevention advice.

Within the month of January:

- Reports of ASB remained the same at 36 reports in both December and January. A few of these relate to drunk and disorderly behaviour.
- There was 1 report of burglary in January.
- There were 9 reports of criminal damage in January.



Patrols:

There were 8 foot patrols within the month of January along with 2 school visits by Youth Officers. The average patrol time was just over 40 minutes.

Specifics:

- 1 attempt motorbike theft on Cambridge Road
- 3 reports of damage/thefts within Waterloo Street Arch



Key Priorities:

- To see more patrols in hotspot areas such as the green spaces, Waterloo Street gardens and surrounding roads, and along the general thoroughfare of Western Road.
