

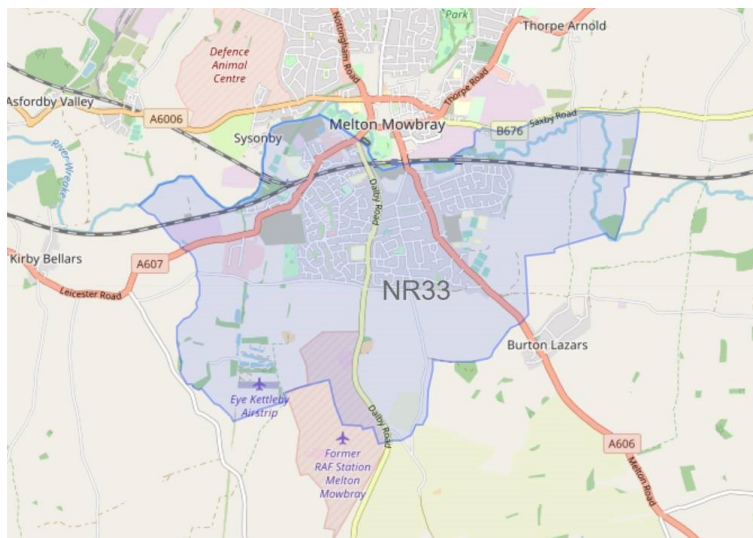

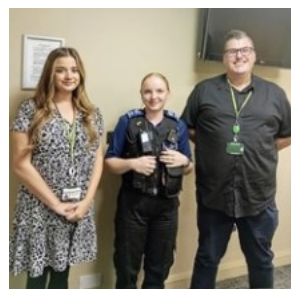
# Melton Town South Beat

## What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and are prioritising the following.

### Priority 1. Drug Dealing

You said: That drug dealing on the Melton Town South Beat is a concern for you.

What we are going to do. \*Targeted Patrols\* \*Intelligence development\* \*Supporting vulnerable people.

### Priority 2. Road Safety Issues

You said: That speeding vehicles are a concern for you on the Melton Town South Beat. You have also raised that vehicles are entering zones and exceeding the weight limits.

What we are going to do. \*Speed enforcement events\* \*Visible traffic calming monitoring

### Priority 3. Antisocial Behaviour

You Said: That antisocial behaviour was a concern for you with off road motorbikes causing a nuisance and persons congregating in certain areas urinating and using abusive language.

What we are going to do. \*Targeted patrols\* \*Partnership working\* \*Education Events
