# Priority 1

## ○ **Shoplifting**

- Shoplifting reports have increased this quarter to 13 total reports. The increase in reports has primarily been down to Sainsbury's reporting more incidents to Police.
- The team regularly attend Sainsbury's and speak with Security and the general manager to discuss incidents and review CCTV to see if offenders can be identified.
- Recent arrest when Officers were inside Sainsbury's and they were alerted to males attempting to shoplift. One male was found with a knife and subsequently arrested.
- The local team are hoping to be more available to attend Co-Op and again work closely with them, after they have had an increase in shopliftings.

# Priority 2

## ○ *Theft of Pedal Cycle*

- We have seen a reduction in theft of pedal cycles on the Ward with the number dropping to 4 reports over the last period.
- The team have continued to patrol hotspot areas, mainly outside Sainsbury's to act as a deterrent.
- PCSO will continue to complete bike marking events in the ward which are promoted on social media and Met Engage.
- We are expecting this figure to rise over the next quarter due to the time of year and more people being in the town centre over the summer period.



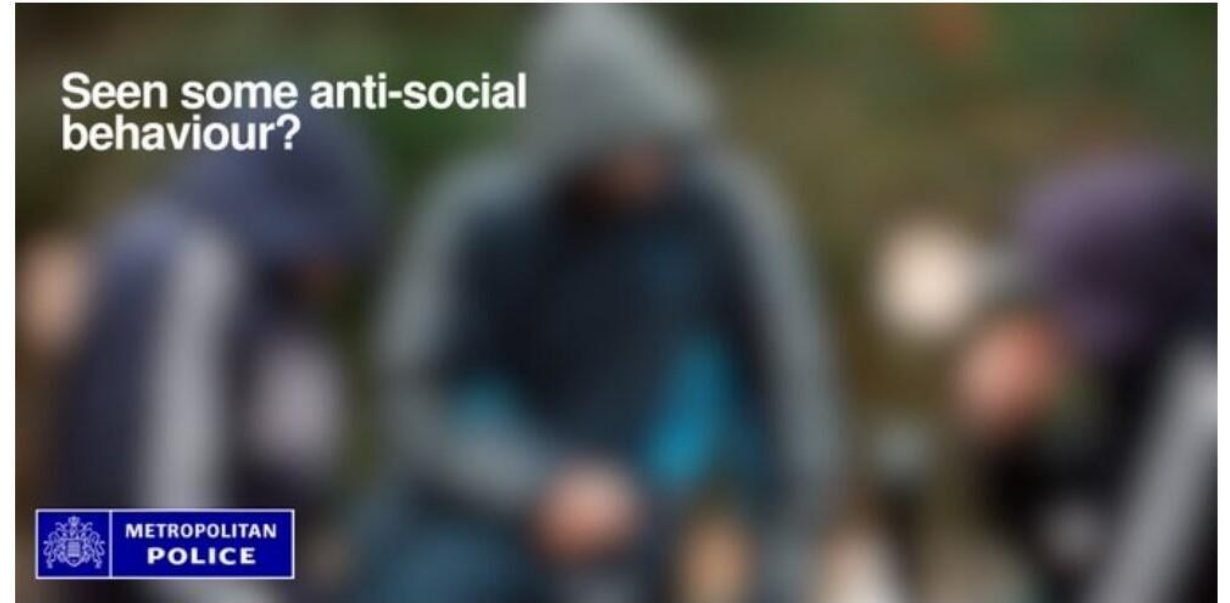

## ○ **Drugs**

- There has been a reduction of Drugs reports on the ward this quarter with there being 7.
- The team continue to regularly attend Canbury Gardens at different points in the shift to complete foot patrols and disrupt any anti-social behaviour and identify any people taking drugs.
- We continue to patrol other hotspot areas, targeting groups of youths. Over the last quarter the team have had 7 drug stop and searches of which 2 were positive for cannabis.
- We have seen an increase in anti-social behaviour in the park, and we hope to disrupt this activity over the next period.

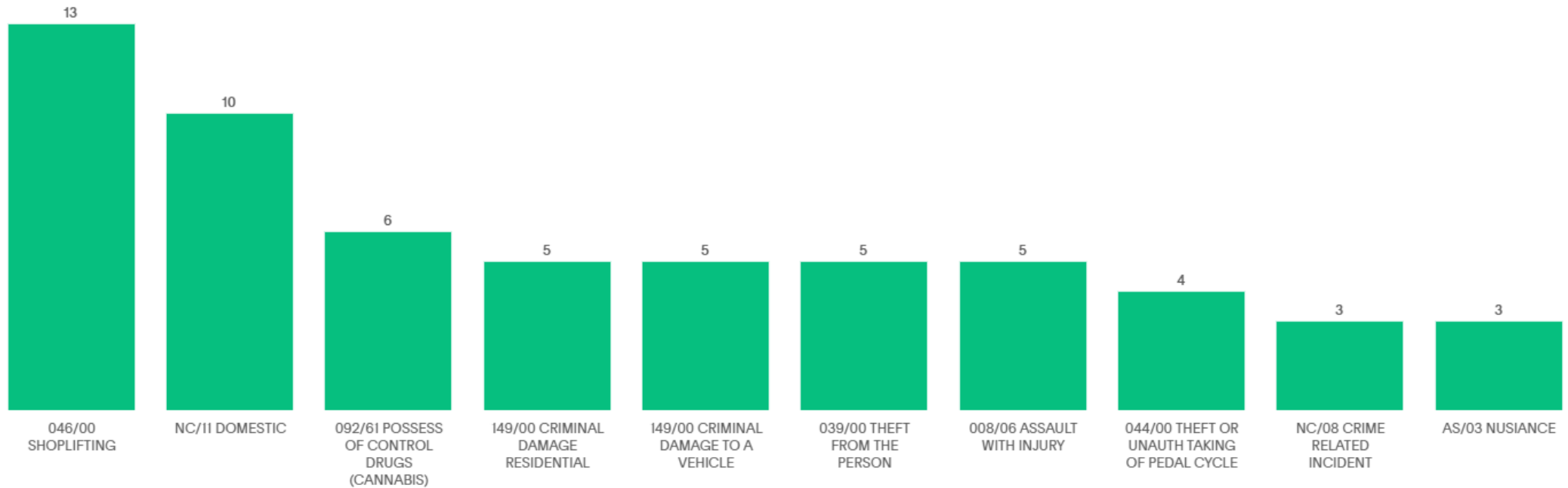
