ASB including general behaviour nuisance motorbikes, noise complaints and drug taking	The beat team are currently investigating anti social behaviour relating to drug and traffic related matters. Perpetrators will be dealt with as per our anti social behaviour incremental approach accordingly.
Burglary	The beat team continue to support our colleagues on response with regards to burglaries that occur in the area by conducting high vis patrols and assisting with investigations where required.
Road safety including nuisance motorbikes, speeding, and highway obstructions.	The beat team have been supporting our colleagues on response with road safety related matters. We have recently had some positive results with a drug driver being caught and a vehicle being seized for having no car tax.

## News



We have conducted ASB patrols in the hotspots all over the beat across Glenfield, Leicester Forest East and Kirby Muxloe. One of the areas is the Morrisons carpark. We have seen a significant decline in ASB in the car park at Morrisons in Glenfield. Whilst out on patrol we noted a very empty looking car park which was not the case a couple of months back. This is mainly because we have been showing a regular presence and have issued a number of Section 59 warnings to drivers using their vehicles anti-socially. Please

be assured we are aware that this problem has not been resolved fully and we'll continue to show our presence and deal with offending drivers. None of this would of been possible without members of the public reporting this to us, so a massive thank you for letting us know of this ongoing problem.

Storm Goretti arrived in some places last month and The Met Office issued an Amber Warning for heavy snow and strong winds. We received a large numbers of calls about vehicles succumbing to the weather and leaving occupants stranded. However, others including myself were left bitterly disappointed after Storm 'Forgetti' missed us entirely! On the topic of weather if you're leaving your vehicle unattended to defrost on your driveway or outside your house—this is a BAD IDEA!!! It can take seconds for a thief to steal it. Stay with your vehicle.

An investigation has begun after 2 males tried to enter a property on Clovelly Road in Glenfield after prising the front lounge window open. The males were disturbed by the occupants and their dog, and made good their escape. This has now been passed onto CID to complete a thorough investigation.

Sgt Pemberton and PCSO Tebbett were deployed to Desford Lane near Kirby Muxloe to help at an incident where a number of cars had driven through a flood and were stranded. The road was closed off with the help of Leicestershire County Council, the water was rising while we were there so please don't risk it, even if you think your car can handle it. If you see a flood that is dangerous please let the council or police know as soon as you can
