#YouSaid - What matters to you.

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following in February 2025.

Priority 1: Theft

You said: You told us that you were concerned about thefts, this can include shop thefts and vehicle break ins in the area. We will try to prioritise this going forward.

Priority 2: Motor vehicle crime

You Said: you told us that you were concerned about vehicle crime this includes anything from theft of vehicle to theft from vehicle.

Priority 3: Road Safety

You Said: You have told us that road safety is a priority, this includes speeding, dangerous driving, no insurance, no MOT, no tax and more.

#WeDid - What we are doing

As part of our ongoing priorities in Lutterworth, we have been focusing on thefts, vehicle crime, and road safety.

- **Thefts:** We have carried out targeted patrols around local shops and car parks, identifying and dealing with known offenders. We've also engaged with businesses to provide crime prevention advice and strengthen links with shop staff.
- **Vehicle crime:** We have increased evening patrols in hotspot areas, spoken to residents about simple security steps they can take to secure their property.
- **Road safety:** We have conducted speed checks in areas raised by the community and offered visible reassurance patrols around schools at peak times. We continue to work with partners to highlight the dangers of speeding and inconsiderate parking.

Keeping Lutterworth Safe

Welcome to the June 2026 update from your Lutterworth Neighbourhood Policing Team. Throughout the month, officers have continued to tackle anti-social behaviour, target criminal activity, recover stolen property and engage with the local community.

Anti-Social Behaviour Patrols Increased

During June, officers increased patrols around **Lutterworth Country Park** and **Leaders Farm Cemetery** following reports of suspected drug use in these locations. High-visibility patrols have been conducted to provide reassurance to the public and deter any criminal or anti-social behaviour.

Counterfeit Note Awareness

Local officers carried out leaflet drops to shops and businesses across the area, providing information supplied by the **Bank of England** on how to identify counterfeit banknotes. This initiative aimed to support local businesses in recognising suspicious notes and reporting concerns.

Vehicle Seizures and Theft Investigations

On **12 June**, officers seized a **quad bike** suspected of being involved in the recent theft of benches from the country park near **Magna Park**. Enquiries remain ongoing.

During the same shift, officers also seized a vehicle found to be on the road **without valid tax or insurance**.

On **14 June**, PCSO colleagues recovered a **stolen vehicle** within the beat area. Investigations are continuing to identify the person responsible and bring them before the courts.

Neighbourhood Action Week – 15 June onwards

The week commencing **15 June** saw the force-wide **Neighbourhood Action Week**, which provided an opportunity for local officers to focus on issues affecting our communities.

Stolen Caravans Recovered – 16 June

On **16 June**, officers from the Lutterworth Beat Team recovered **two stolen caravans**.

A suspect was arrested on suspicion of theft after officers located him asleep inside a vehicle believed to have been used during the commission of the offences. The vehicle was also seized as part of the investigation.

This was an excellent result and demonstrates the proactive work being carried out by neighbourhood officers to tackle acquisitive crime.

Speed Enforcement Activity

As part of Neighbourhood Action Week, speed enforcement operations were conducted on **17 and 18 June**.

The team visited:

The majority of motorists were found to be driving responsibly and within the speed limits. However, **two drivers were reported for speeding** during the operation.
