Current ongoing issues in Matlock.

We are receiving continuous calls for service in relation to anti-social behaviour around the Matlock area.

The areas of interest seem to be Hall Leys Park, Mc Donald's, Hurst Rise and a new building site between Matlock & Tansley.

Antisocial behaviour takes many forms varying from aggressive, noisy or abusive behaviour to neighbourhood disturbances involving drugs, abandoned cars or animals.

We want to tackle the on-going issues swiftly so we would like to encourage you all to report any concerns via the below channels:

- By phoning 101 for non-emergencies.
- By phoning 999 for an emergency.
- By visiting the Derbyshire Constabulary Website and selecting the Report tab and selecting anti-social behaviour tab.
- By messaging the Derbyshire Constabulary Facebook Page as this inbox is monitored 24/7.
- By attending our street meets and making us aware.

We have already begun to issue anti-social behaviour warning letters and banning letters on behalf of Mc Donald's to address the unacceptable behaviour that our local residents are having to endure. Please be assured that relevant action is being taken and high-visibility foot patrols are being conducted!
