### Kidbrooke Village & Sutcliffe Ward

The Ward Panel was held on the 28/04/2026 at The Kidbrooke Village Hall and members had the opportunity to talk about the emerging issues on the ward.

The first quarter crime statistics were presented and discussed. A copy of these can be found attached to this Newsletter for your awareness. Emerging issues raised in the meeting directly to local officers were:

- \* ASB in Cator Park and Sutcliffe Park.
- \* Rise in parcel theft at multiple locations on the ward.
- \* Bike Theft and Drug use.

The new ward priorities are:

- 1- Parcel theft
- 2- Residential burglary
- 3- Anti social behaviour

Whilst on foot patrol your Local Officers at Cator Park responded to an incident involving a group of youths, 3 suspects were detained, 1 was arrested and taken to custody.

2 shoplifters were arrested and charged for offences at Pegler square shops and Aldi.

The Team attended a variety of community meetings and events involving local schools, residents from Weigall Road, Courtland's and Ravens Way at the neighborhood watch AGM. We talked and listened to residents' concerns in their area.

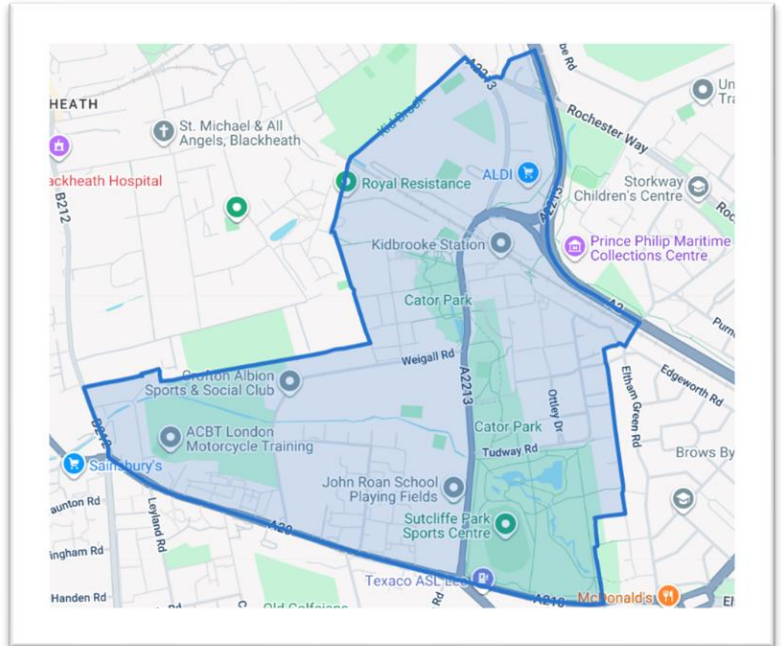
