### *Beat Priorities for January/February/March 2025*

#### **1) Drug Dealing & Anti-Social Behaviour**

We have received reports of drug use and associated ASB. Our team is working closely with residents and partner agencies to find long-term solutions.

### **School Parking Patrols**

The Beat Team have been out conducting parking patrols outside the following schools.

### **Licensing Checks**

### **Crime Prevention Advice – Keeping Our Community Safe**

#### **Home Security**

- Always lock doors and windows, even when you're at home.
- Consider using timer switches for lights if you're out in the evening.

#### **Vehicle Safety**

- Never leave your vehicle unattended with the engine running.
- Remove valuables such as bags, tools, and electronics from view.

Double check your vehicle is locked before walking away.

#### **Online & Scam Awareness**

- Be cautious of unexpected emails, texts, or calls asking for money or personal details.
- Legitimate organisations will *never* pressure you to act quickly.

If something feels wrong—stop and check before responding.

#### **Look Out for Each Other**

- Report any suspicious behaviour, unusual vehicles, or activity that seems out of place.
- Keep an eye on vulnerable neighbours and share advice where appropriate.

#### **How to Report**

- Non-emergency: 101 or online via the Leicestershire Police website
- Always dial 999 in an emergency

You can also report concerns or pass on information anonymously through Crime Stoppers.

Any details—no matter how small—can help us identify those responsible and prevent further incidents.
