What we have been up to

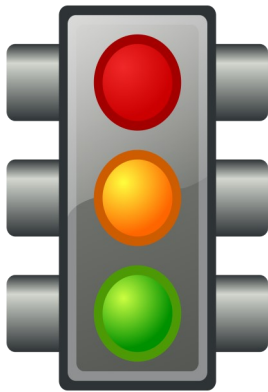
We carried out some great partnership working with the Safe Community Team at Melton Borough Council to target an address that was being used for suspected drug offences as well as causing a significant amount of ASB to the neighbourhood

A warrant was carried out by Police with an amount of drugs being seized. We then issued a Closure notice on the address, with evidence from the local community, Council Officers and Police Officers. We then attended Magistrates court to apply for a full order. Which once the evidence was sworn in, the Magistrates have granted the order for a term of 3 months. Making it an offence for anyone to be at the property (with a couple of exceptions) Whilst the property is now boarded up, it is bringing peace to the street and has disrupted the drug use and supply in the area

There are a whole host of additional orders and powers that we and the local authority can apply for and action. As with all things, reports are the key to this sort of enforcement, thank you to all that reported this as an issue.



Op Flux—Road Safety #YouSaidWeDid



As part of a local operation that focused on road safety and those using the road network for various types of criminality, officers have been patrolling a number of locations that are well known for speeding across the beat.

Speed checks have been conducted across the beat using speed guns and numerous vehicles have been stopped with various offences identified and intelligence submitted.

We continue to encourage residents on the beat to report vehicles regarding any concerns
