

## Important notice to residents

### **NOTICE TO RESIDENTS: VOLKS WAGON BADGE/ SENSOR THEFTS**

Dear Residents,

We have recently received several reports and it appears there has been a series **thefts of Volks Wagon badges** from vehicles in the NORTHFIELD area. Potentially not all of these offences have been reported to police.

We believe that the thieves are removing the front badges to gain access a sensor on the vehicle which is of value. Suspects are believed to operate in the early hours of the morning.

We urge that all residents that have been a victim of Thefts from Motor vehicle report this by calling **101** or via the online met police reporting service on [www.met.police.uk](http://www.met.police.uk).

We are asking residents to review their CCTV and doorbell footage from **Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2026** onwards to see if suspects can be identified.

#### **Crime prevention advice:**

- Remain vigilant keeping an eye on any suspicious activity within the neighbourhood.
- If possible park your car close to your home.
- Ensure your car is fitted with a working alarm
- Use of CCTV and door bell cameras to act as a deterrent
- Install motion sensored lights where vehicles are parked on your driveway

Again if you have been a victim please make a formal report to police by calling **101** or via the online met police reporting service on [www.met.police.uk](http://www.met.police.uk). Reporting crime will help to build a bigger picture of the amount of thefts that have taken place and in which locations thereafter relevant CCTV can then be obtained and potential suspects can be identified.
