Report 1

Residential Burglary – burglary THREE (3) and ONE (1) Attempted, on Monday, Wednesday & Thursday

Hotspot areas: North of the ward

- **ONE (1) Attempted:** First- Resident was away and attempt made from First Floor Window.
- **THREE (3) Residential:** *First:* TWO suspects tailgated into the property above a shop and stole personal items from the resident. *Second:* TWO suspects trespassed onto a residential property, and they decamped when they realised the occupants were at home? *Third:* Suspicious circumstances where the victim suspects theft from her home.

Theft from motor vehicle – FOUR (4)

Hotspot areas: North of the ward.

What times? Day time and evening Time: Saturday & Sunday

CRIME PREVENTION ADVICE

- ✓ **Remember:** Empty car policy – Nothing to see, nothing to take!
- ✓ This month, TWO (2) car windows smashed and the following properties stolen from within: TWO (2) parcel shelves. ONE (1) Theft of front number plates from m/v. ONE (1) Catalytic Converter stolen from m/v.
- ✓ To deter catalytic converter theft, consider using products like the CatClamp, Cateye alarm system or Monroe Cat Cage, which provide effective protection against this growing issue.
- ✓ **To prevent theft of car parcel shelves, which are targeted for resale (often fetching £75–£150) due to quick, 20-second removal times, it is recommended to remove the shelf and store it indoors overnight. If it must remain in the car, park in well-lit, busy areas, ideally under CCTV.**
- ✓ Motor vehicle – never leave any property in the car for anyone to see? Take it inside or put it in the boot (covered). **Remember** to look after your disabled Badges - if not secured in a disabled Badge holder (see

- **Theft of motor vehicle – ONE (1)**
- **Time:** Evening **Date:** 11/2/26
- **CRIME PREVENTION ADVICE**
- Unknown suspect has stolen a locked motor bike from parking bay
- Motorcycle, Moped/scooters must Lock, Chain and Cover. Click on the link below for crime prevention advice

- **Do Faraday bags work for key fobs?**
- **A Faraday bag will protect your keyless entry fob from being hacked and used to start your car without you knowing.** Faraday sleeves protect valuable devices from electronic pickpockets and vehicles from electronic car thieves
- **Remember: Advise to the Wise – “A Tracker installed in the motor vehicle help to locate and recover the vehicle”.**
- How do police track stolen cars?
- When a vehicle is stolen the Tracker device emits a unique Very High Frequency signal. This can be picked by the police **using the Tracker technology installed in their vehicles** to help track stolen vehicles. A tracker was installed in the motor vehicle, and the owners of the car were able to locate & recover. (*Tracker™ Vehicle Tracking Systems Utilise VHF Tracking to Help Locate Your Stolen Vehicle*)
