Fraud Advice if looking to rent a property.

Fraudsters create fake listings on legitimate rental platforms to lure victims into rental scams. Always view the property before making a payment. Students sometimes feel pressured into making a payment to secure sought after accommodation. Check and verify the information and landlord as much as possible. Ideally use a registered letting

agent but beware of fake listings copied from legitimate companies. Avoid bank transfers and use credit cards instead.
