## Reporting A Crime

### In An Emergency

Dial **999** for emergencies or where a crime is actually going on.

If you have a hearing or speech impairment, use our textphone service **18000** or **text on 999** if you have pre-registered with the emergencySMS service.

Remember to ensure you are safe to call. If not, get to a safe place then make the call.

### When It Is Not An Emergency

Dial **101**: to report something that has happened or a suspicious circumstance not amounting to an emergency.

### Report Online

To report online rather than use 101 use the Metropolitan Police Website:

Note reports can also be made here about stolen vehicles, missing persons, lost & found, anti-social behaviour and road traffic incidents.
