We have listened to you and the concerns you raise

Our beat priorities continue to be:

Priority 1: ASB. What we are going to do: The beat team aim to tackle incidences of ASB within the villages including the parks and beauty spots of Charnwood West utilising ASB and civil legislation and patrols in locations identified as subject to ASB.

Priority 2: Speeding and Road safety. What we are going to do: The beat team will deal with issues of road safety and speeding in Charnwood West villages. If you believe that there is an issue in your area, let the beat team know.

Priority 3: Drugs. What we are going to do: The beat team will deal with incidences of drug use and dealing across the beat area. Patrolling identified areas, utilising stop search powers where available and develop intelligence to allow us to target dealing within your area.

The Charnwood West Dedicated Neighbourhood Team have been working throughout September to tackle our chosen priorities of Speeding and Road Traffic Safety, Anti Social Behaviour and Drugs (including use and drug dealing).

All the team featuring Sergeant Adkin, PC Nicholson, PCSO Martin and PCSO Colley have been working both out on the beat engaging with the community, and completing essential behind the scenes administrative work on the below and other aspects of policing:

Speeding and Road Traffic Safety

Throughout September, the Charnwood West Beat Team carried out targeted speed operations in response to community concerns. On 24th September at 9:00am, officers monitored 50 vehicles along Bier Way in Rothley, resulting in one warning being issued. A further operation took place on 28th September at 2:00pm on Forest Road in Woodhouse, where 158 vehicles were checked. Of those, four were found travelling above 35mph, with the highest recorded speed being 37mph. Advice letters were issued to the drivers involved. The Beat Team remains committed to maintaining a high-visibility presence in areas where speeding has been raised as a concern, helping to keep our roads safe for everyone. We appreciate the community's continued support.

Anti-Social Behaviour

The Charnwood West Beat Team continues to respond to concerns raised by residents and the parish council by patrolling identified anti-social behaviour (ASB) hotspots. Where appropriate, officers have applied the Incremental Approach issuing words of advice and warning letters to those causing disruption. A community resolution was recently issued to an address in Rothley, and in partnership with Charnwood Borough Council, a Notice of Seeking Possession (NOSP) was served at another property in the area. The team also attended a multi-agency meeting regarding ASB at Ploughlands in Quorn, where positive preventative measures have now been put in place. We remain committed to deterring and investigating ASB and encourage residents to report any concerns via 101 or online.

Drugs and Drug Dealing

The Charnwood West Beat Team has been actively conducting high-visibility patrols in areas linked to drug use and supply. Officers have been gathering and submitting intelligence on individuals and locations suspected of involvement, with a particular focus on Quorn, Rothley, and Woodhouse Eaves. This intelligence is being developed further to support ongoing investigations. Recently, an arrest was made in Quorn, resulting in the seizure of two quantities of Class B drugs, along with items associated with drug dealing, including scales and cash. The team is working closely with the Neighbourhood Priority Team to address properties and hotspots connected to drug-related activity, reinforcing our commitment to keeping the community safe.
