

# Protect your home from high value gold jewellery theft



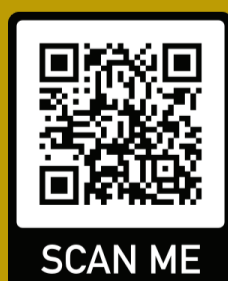
The sharp rise in the price of gold means that gold jewellery is a serious target for thieves. Remember, thefts can occur at any time, even if you are at home.

You can reduce the chances of your high value gold jewellery being targeted by following our self-help advice tips;

- Store valuable items in a safety deposit box at your bank or in a safe at home which is screwed to either a wall or floor
- Take photos of high value gold jewellery
- Always set your CCTV to record
- Lock doors and windows and use sash jammers even when you are inside the house
- Install Anti-Snap locks and a camera doorbell

If you have been the victim of high value gold jewellery theft, or if you have seen suspicious activity, you can report it by calling **101**. If a crime is in progress, always dial **999**.
