Kidbrooke Village & Sutcliffe Ward

The Team conducted three stop and searches positive for class A drugs, community resolution issued, one positive outcome for shoplifting offences and charge.

This is still an ongoing issue that we take very seriously, and we will continue to target over the coming weeks by undertaking proactive high-visibility and plain clothes patrols.

Officers were deployed on Ramadan patrols all over Greenwich, reassuring communities around mosques and targeted areas.

Thank you to everyone that attended the **Violence against women and girls**, Walk and talk with Greenwich Community Safety Team to visit areas on Kidbrooke Village and Eltham Page wards.

We are researching on proactive ways we can support and police the problematic areas highlighted to us on the day.

Residents highlighted concerns in the footpath behind Aldi, the area is a dense green area, and young girls feel vulnerable when crossing the area.

The team has made contact with TFL highlighting the issues and requesting a walk and meeting with SNT, to discuss what can be done to improve lighting, visibility and safety.

We have approached Thomas Tallis school with the aim to do presentations on safety and awareness to pupils to ensure youths feel comfortable walking home at night and being safer from strangers.

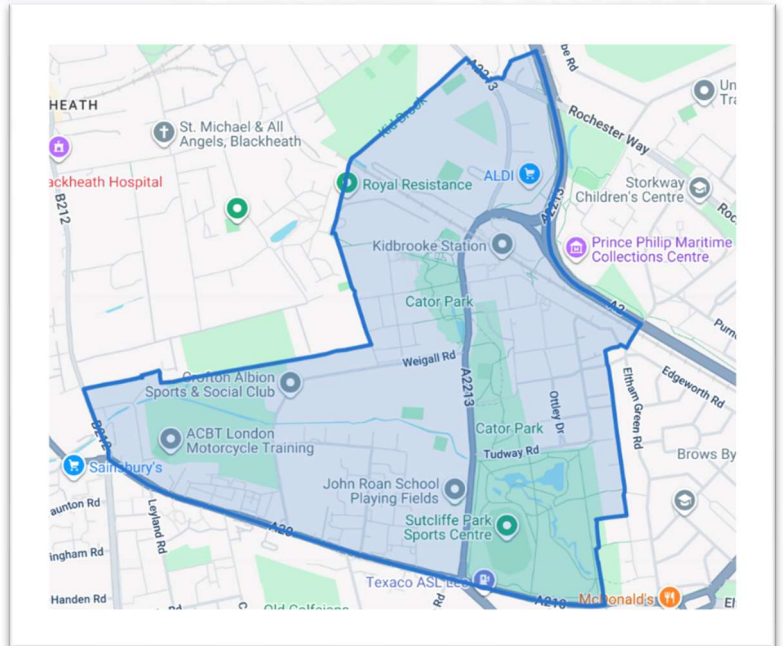
