What matters to you

We have revised our beat priorities as of April 2026 to reflect what we have been told concerns the community most.

- **Priority 1: ASB in Open Spaces**

What we did: Victoria Park has been a hive of activity throughout the summer. Despite the heightened footfall, very few incidents of note have been reported. We have liaised with the LCC Park Rangers who have confirmed relatively few concerns despite the increased activity in the open areas. Scattered reports of drug use in other areas have been reported to us which will go to shape our patrolling plans as the seasons change.

- **Priority 2: Theft and Shoplifting**

What we did: Ongoing visits and established operations have caught shoplifters in the act leading to detentions and arrests of individuals that have been wanted for series' of thefts across the Leicester city area. Intelligence received from the public has also gone to help us a great amount to identify a previously unknown prolific thief.

- **Priority 3: Vulnerable People**

What we Did: PCSO Sanghera has visited Residential homes in the Clarendon Park area throughout August after residents were concerned around scammers and cold callers to independent properties. We would advise anyone to familiarise themselves with what to look out for and who to report to if unsure with any visitors at the door.
