What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following from October 2024.

Priority 1: Significant rise in Drug Dealing and Drug Use. **What we are going to do:** Targeted patrols to identify drug dealers and drug users in key locations, disrupt them and seek to identify and close down supply lines being used. Working closely with local residents and councils to gather intelligence to assist with tackling the problem. Stop and search powers are being deployed in the key locations.

Priority 2: Burglaries around the A6 Villages. **What we are going to do:** High visibility patrols around all areas of the beat with dedicated patrols later into the evening specifically aimed at preventing burglary opportunities. Burglary advice and leaflets are being provided during the beat surgeries and also via neighbourhood link.

Priority 3: Anti-Social Behaviour. **What we are going to do:** Dedicated ASB Car has been in force to assist with any anti-social behaviour that is occurring. Regular patrols by the beat team in high priority locations have also enable the force to see a large reduction in ASB related crime.
