Neighbourhood watch has now officially replaced Online Watch Link (OWL) and the team are doing their best to raise awareness of this so that we can keep our ward members informed and communication between our team and the community remains strong. If you have not signed up for this, please do so as the team will be using this platform to provide crime prevention advice/tips and information in regard to upcoming community engagements and initiatives. The team have remained focused on their ward priorities and have kept violence against women and girls, motor vehicle crime, shoplifting and ASB as their core focus. In order to be effective at these ward priorities, the team increased their evening patrols over the Christmas period and patrolled areas that were highlighted by the community as being intimidating. The team have pro-actively worked with security at stores in an attempt to reduce shoplifting as the team are aware that this is currently a cause for concern on the ward. The team have also continued carrying out community weapon sweeps using metal detectors to identify and locate weapons and articles adapted for use as weapons. Areas affected by motor vehicle crime have been patrolled extensively and crime prevention advice has been provided via the teams community engagements. The team have made great efforts to increase their policing presence on the ward and have received positive feedback from local businesses and the community.
