## STRANGER DANGER

Over the past couple of months there has been a number of reports of males approaching youths, understandably this has resulted in a higher state of awareness. The Northwich Guardian has reported on these reports which has served to further cause concern within the community.

At present, officers are looking into all reported incidents, but these are not thought to be linked.

#### **TIMELINE:**

<u>AUG</u>—two incidents reported, within the same week which resulted in a SOCIAL MEDIA post being published on our social media channels to promote communication from Parent to child and vice versa. If anything happens to you, tell parents straight away. And Parents to advise their children not to speak to anyone they don't know and what to do if something suspicious does happen.

OCT- further incident (which fits the description of the last two incidents in AUGUST but at this time there is nothing to link these events. Further investigation is taking place). CCTV has been obtained and vehicle details obtained.

<u>OCT</u>— further incident which is not related to the previous, due to different vehicle and male. No registration details were obtained, but CCTV has identified a potential suspect.

Below are the issues that the community policing team are dealing with ...

## **WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW**

#### **ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN**

- Suspicious activity from neighbours in relation to what they are buying and doing to their property—this has been placed as INTEL
- Possible fighting coming from neighbours address—RESPONSE officers were
  dispatched, attended the address were noise was coming and spoke to residents.
  There were friends at the address but no issues. This has been placed as INTEL.
  No need for reassurance visit
- Male youth has assaulted another student with LEFTWICH HIGH SCHOOL—PCSO ROBERTSON has contacted school to get information about this and to gain CCTV. School has spoken to all parties involved and PCSO ROBERTSON, PC WARD has spoken to the male who assaulted.
- Male youth waiting by the Bus shelter and using a lighter to ignite bits of paper—NO
  CCTV in area, but passed to PCSO ROBERTSON for his awareness—no other
  reports

#### THEFT

Royal Mail has delivered item to possibly the wrong person and they have signed for it
 PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit

#### **THEFT** (other)

 Possible blackmail due to the reporting person doing a sexual act on video call, and the other party took a screenshot and stated "they were going to put it online" - PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit

#### THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE

 Reporting person noticed that there car boot and doors where slightly open and items were taken - CRIMED and is being tasked to officer for investigation if there are routes for enquiry

#### **BURGULARY**

Reporting person noticed gate was open and that SHED window was also open.
 Entered the shed to find secateurs and a crowbar which don't belong to them. Bike was taken- CRIMED, RESPONSE OFFICER attended. PCSO ROBERTSON will complete reassurance and safe guarding advice in surrounding area and social media

#### **HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION**

Vehicle is parked too close to the junction of LONDON ROAD on THE CRESCENT —
 PCSO ROBERTSON dispatched and vehicle is a little too close to the junction—
 Vehicle owner located and advised to parked further back.

## **LEFTWICH**

#### **ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN**

- Son of reporting person received a threatening SNAPCHAT message from a male in the same year group—PCSO ROBERTSON will attend for reassurance visit to gain more information in regards to this
- Possible attempt to harm reporting person due to damage done to property—Officers tried to contact reporting person as they hung up, but went straight to voicemail.
   Officers have looked into this and correct procedure has been provided
- Male has checked out of the WOODPECKER and a sword has been found in the room
  afterwards, Male came back to state that he left something in the room. When staff
  challenged him in regards to this, male ran off—Item has been seized by RESPONSE
  officers and INTEL placed in regarding the male
- Male in a black car followed two young females—females done completely the right thing by not engaging. CCTV has been obtained and Vehicle registration has been gained from the CCTV. Ongoing investigation
- Male has approached reporting person whilst in NORTHWICH TOWN and made threats— PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit
- Two males out with a large dog (which is not on a lead) drinking vodka—PCSO
  ROBERTSON was not on duty at the time of report, will conduct a reassurance
  visit to gain more information
- Reporting person is stating that they need someone as they feel like she is going to have a fit—Not a police deployment, therefore has been passed to AMBULANCE
- Young male seen sat on the side of the road at 6am and there is concerns for him— RESPONSE officers dispatched and young male located. Male had been out with friends and upset that he had a relationship which just ended. Male was taken home
- Suspicious activity from a male leaving his van and talking to young girls—this is a
  duplicate report of an incident that has already been reported and is being
  investigated
- Expensive racing bike being abandoned outside a property—PCSO ROBERTSON located the bike, took back to NORTHWICH POLICE STATION and booked in.

#### **CRIMINAL DAMAGE**

Vehicle has been damaged overnight —CRIMED and is being investigated

#### **BURGULARY**

Reporting person states that there bank book may have been taken from property as

they can not find it - PCSO HAMBLETON (SHAKERLEY) was dispatched due to PCSO ROBERTSON being off duty and spoke to reporting person and advised what to do in regards to the book. No money has been taken and reporting person will contact bank.



## **KINGSMEAD**

#### **ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN**

- Youths throwing eggs at house and vehicle PCSO ROBERTSON will attend and view footage of both incidents
- Male youth attending an address and threatening the reporting person and family members—PCSO ROBERTSON and RESPONSE officers attended the address and PCSO ROBERTSON is aware on the ongoing issues and is looking into this, as this is involving a past incident
- Further issues with youths attending above address and kicking door—targeted issue—
   PCSO ROBERTSON is dealing with all of the above and has spoken to over 10 youths which are involved and issuing COMMUNITY RESOLUTIONS due to this.
- Two male youths jumping the SIR JOHN DEANES fence and smoking and giving staff abuse when asked to leave—PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit to see if there is any CCTV. Has been told there is CCTV of who may be involved from a resident who he is going to collect.
- Person knocked on mothers door and asked for her details—PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit
- Male who has been in the river (as wet head to toe) is staggering about, not sure if drunk—Not a police response issue, therefore passed to RIGHT CARE RIGHT PERSON

#### **CRIMINAL DAMAGE**

 Youth attending above address and kicking owners car—this is all linked to the above incidents. PCSO ROBERTSON has CCTV of whose involved and is conducting home visits

#### **HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION**

 Vehicle looks like its been abandoned on the A556 causing issues for people leaving HILL TOP GRANGE — RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched and vehicle recovered and removed due to causing obstructions

#### **SHOPLIFTING**

- Report of shoplifting from TESCO—Crimed, CCTV has been requested
- 2nd report of shoplifting from TESCO, youths involved. CCTV will be gained and investigated



## **DAVENHAM**

#### **ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN**

- Ongoing neighbour issue which may of led to paint being thrown over vehicle— PCSO ROBERTSON and PC BOX has spoken to neighbour and gave a COMMUNITY RESOLUTION to the neighbour who threw the paint
- Possible drug use at a neighbours address due to the strong smell of CANNABIS—Has been inputted as INTEL and caller advised to ring again if there are further issues.
   PCSO ROBERTSON will contact caller for reassurance
- Potential intruder in the rear garden—Safeguarding advice given, reporting person states can not see anyone just hears rustling leaves—PCSO ROBERTSON will also attend to do REASSURANCE VISIT
- Possibly next door neighbour has died—RESPONSE officers were dispatched and conducted welfare check, neighbour is safe and well, neighbour issue which PC BOX / PCSO ROBERTSON are looking into
- Number of bikes going up the wrong way up HARTFORD ROAD and then doing a bike meet at the ODDFELLOWS—PCSO ROBERTSON will contact Reporting Person and the Cheshire West and Chester to fix the No entry signs

#### **BURGULARY**

 Keys have been moved and lights have been switch on and there has been a similar incident reported on FACEBOOK—PCSO ROBERTSON has been made aware from this by a colleague and will conduct a reassurance visit

## **BOSTOCK**

#### **ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN**

Two males suspicious seen on the farm in the car park, where staff park. Males seen filming the vehicles there — logged as INTEL. PCSO ROBERTSON will attend to speak to reporting person and gain more information

#### **HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION**

 Vehicle possibly been abandoned in the middle of the road—RESPONSE officers dispatched and Vehicle removed



## **MOULTON** ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Female getting abuse online on TIK TOK by another person and that person is spreading lies online— PCSO ROBERTSON will attend address for reassurance visit
- Person being threatened online and two other individuals possibly harassing the reporting person online—RESPONSE officers have arranged an appointment with the reporting person, PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit after the appointment
- Vehicle has been parked on REGENT STREET for the past month, and there only has
  been one person attend the vehicle to take things out of it. PCSO ROBERTSON has
  checked the vehicle, it is not causing an obstruction and therefore can not be
  removed by police. Will monitor and if abandoned will take action when it comes
  to it
- Elderly male possibly fallen and cant get up due to the banging and saying "he cant reach his phone" - No deployment from police—ambulance matter (RIGHT CARE RIGHT PERSON)
- Male seen approaching reporting persons garage—
- Further report in regards to male, as now been seen outside the property the following day —has been caught on RING DOOR CAM, PCSO ROBERTSON conducted a reassurance visit and has obtained images of the male. PC BOX made aware of the issue
- Suspicious male hanging around the park area, and then other males joined that male and was staring at reporting person—has been logged as INTEL. PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit
- Suspicious male in a van approaching daughter—PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit, CCTV Is being looked into around the area.

#### THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

• Vehicle was borrowed by a family member. That relationship has broken down and the vehicle has not been returned—**possibly a civil matter** 

#### **FRAUD**

- Caller received a letter from his car insurance stating that two other vehicles had tried to be added , plus money had been taken from bank account for a GO FUND ME page
- 3rd report in regards to this to due further communication—PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a home reassurance visit.

#### **HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION**

Vehicle possibly parking and blocking driveway of reporting person—Vehicle details
have been passed over to PCSO ROBERTSON and been placed onto parking patrol

#### **WILDLIFE**

People walking around a protected area which has badger sets and they are digging —
 RURAL CRIME officer dispatched—workmen checking drains with landowners permission.

#### **CRIMINAL DAMAGE**

 Amazon van has collided with the height restriction barrier and its knocked it out of the ground—crimed

## **MINI POLICE**

#### MINI POLICE COURT BACK IN SESSION

This past month the MINI POLICE held one of their COURTS again in KINGSMEAD, which tackles speeding within the community.

The MINI POLICE work along side NORTHWICH SOUTH COMMUNITY OFFICERS.

When a driver is caught speeding by officers who have the TRU CAM SPEED GUN, they are pulled over and given a choice:

- take the points (if course is not available) together with Fine
- or attend the MINI POLICE COURT

This current COURT occurred on MONARCH DRIVE in KINGSMEAD and over the course of the hour, 4 drivers were caught speeding and all attended the MINI POLICE COURT.

At the court the Mini Police interview the driver about how and why they are speeding within their area.

As they left, some of the feedback that was received included:

"that was tough , they don't hold back"
"I wont forget that straight away"

"Wow I've learnt my lesson"

The Mini Police Courts are one of more impactful patrols / sessions we do with the MINI POLICE and with that more courts are planned for the future.



## **And Finally**



On Friday, Cheshire Constabulary held their annual ACE (achieving Cheshire Excellence) awards. And we are proud to announce that PCSO Robertson won the PCSO of The Year Award.

PCSO Robertson has been the Davenham and Moulton (which also covers the Leftwich, Kingsmead area for the past 4½ years. He won the award for his dedication to his job role, the work he has done within the community and for giving the community a voice.

Over the past year PCSO Robertson has worked on and developed the Mini Police program and made it into a HMRC recognized program that has now been rolled out to other areas within Cheshire. Also, along with developing the program, PCSO Robertson has worked with his own Mini Police at Kingsmead primary

School, which has gone on to win National Awards. And with the success he has achieved with the Kingsmead Mini Police, he has now gained 2 more teams of Mini Police, with Davenham CofE Primary joining the program last year and now Leftwich Primary joining this year.

His dedication to his role is his number 1 priority, which has been recognised with this award.

Huge congratulations, we are truly proud of him.
