

The Cambridge Gardens Estate is subject to a closure order from court that commenced on o8th May 2025 and will be enforced for a period of three months. Access to the communal areas of the estate is prohibited for persons not on the authorized list.



Bike Marking Engagement Event





Housing Surgery Meeting

PCSO JJINGO attended the Housing Surgery meeting at the Queen Mary Hall Cambridge Gardens on Thursday 12th June 2025 together with Kingston Council housing officers. We talked about the enforcement of the closure order in place at the Cambridge Gardens and effectiveness in reducing ASB Nuisance on both estates. Preventing trespassers from accessing empty properties on the Cambridge Estate, reporting and preventing fly tipping. Addressing concerns of the residents from both estates in attendance All entrances to the Cambridge Estate have notices of the closure order to be in place for three months since the 8th May 2025.

Street a Week, We continue to conduct a 'street-a week' initiative, conducting a door to door campaign introducing to Residents the METENGAGE Platform and helping them to sign up. It is a brand new platform through which you will receive updates from your local police officers on issues that matter most to you. Services will be tailored to the community needs. It will be rolled out across the city of London. Residents will be able to tailor their interests on the platform to their handsets and will be able to message back to the MET Police using the platform.
