**Tackling Violence against Women and Girls (VAWG)**

**Be behaviour aware.**

- Unwanted comments about appearance
- Unwanted attention
- Not treating women as equals

**is Misogyny**

- Following or causing distress
- Not taking no for an answer
- Repeated unwanted behaviour

**is Harassment**

- Unwanted sexual and physical contact
- Taking explicit photos without consent
- Sexual assault and rape

**is Sexual Violence**

VAWG is a complex issue and this poster highlights some of the behaviours that **won't be tolerated**. Behaviours that make people uncomfortable or threatened **are not ok**.
