One4All Advice Services

The Aberdare One4All centre is based out of Aberdare Library, running on an appointment-based service to offer assistance to those making an application of submitting evidence for a blue badge, concessionary bus pass, council tax and discounts, or housing benefit.

If you'd like to speak to the One4All, you can book an appointment at the library counter or via telephone. One4All centres do not offer drop-in services or advice. You can also make council related payments by using the payment kiosk located in the library.
