# Safe and Found Online

## The digital information bank to help locate vulnerable missing people.

Safe and Found Online is a simple, secure way to help police locate a vulnerable person more quickly if they go missing. The digital forms follow the nationally recognised Herbert Protocol and Forcer Protocol.

**Herbert Protocol:** A scheme aimed at reducing harm to people living with dementia by enabling swift access to essential details that help police locate them quickly.

**Forcer Protocol:** Designed to protect service veterans, active military personnel and reservists who go missing.

### How it works

- Complete the relevant online registration form with key information
- Details such as a recent photo, routines, medication and places they may be drawn to can be stored safely and securely.
- If the person goes missing, the police can access this information immediately to help focus the search.

### Why register?

- Faster searches – vital details are already prepared should an emergency occur.
- Reassurance for families – peace of mind knowing you've taken a proactive step.
- Supports emergency services – gives officers the information they need to provide the best possible response and act without delay.

### Who can sign up?

- Anyone caring for a person with dementia.
- Veterans, serving military personnel and reservists.
- Individuals can also register themselves.
- There is **no cost** and registration only takes a few minutes.
