

## **Brunswick and Adelaide PCSO Monthly Update**

Hi all!

This is your current ward update for Brunswick and Adelaide, looking back at the month just gone, and offering current crime prevention advice.



### **Within the month of July:**

- Reports of ASB increased to 56 reports.
- There were 2 reports of burglaries.
- There were 9 reports of criminal damage.

### **Patrols:**



There were 26 patrols within the month of July. The average patrol time was 67 minutes. 5 of these patrols focused specifically within the business communities.

### **Specifics:**

- 4 reports of motorbike theft/attempt theft from within the ward area
- 4 reports of ASB/drug use in Palmeira Square
- 1 report of drug use within Boundary Passage



### **Key Priorities:**

- To see more continued patrols in hotspot areas such as the green spaces, Waterloo Street gardens and surrounding roads, and along the general thoroughfare of Western Road.
- We are aware there have been several reports regarding tents on Hove Lawns and the green spaces in the ward. While police can address concerns regarding antisocial and criminal behaviour, we cannot remove tents. Please make reports to BHCC regarding tents.
