What matters to you

Through Neighbourhood Link, social media and local engagement events, we have listened and will be prioritising the following -

Priority - You Said -

We have been made aware of issues surrounding drugs and County Lines activity in Coalville which have been identified to specific streets and addresses. This includes related vehicle ASB and potential drug dealing from specific specific addresses.

Action Taken - We Did

Work continues in relation to two Closure Orders across the beat and we have also made arrests in relation to an existing property subject to a closure order. This is a continuous procedure which we will persevere with to obtain positive results.

Priority - You Said

Reports of off-road bikes on green areas within the beat area causing noise nuisance and general ASB.

Action Taken - We Did

We continue to conduct active patrols in areas you have raised issues in to us. Further Section 59 notices have been issued which give Police the power to seize those vehicles causing nuisance to others. If those vehicles are used again in an anti-social manner, we will seize them.

Priority - You Said

Repeated offences and offenders targeting town centre shops.

Action Taken - We Did

We take theft from stores offences seriously. This month we have been continue to work with partners and will assist in the distribution of retail radio units which provide a direct link to police when incidents are reported.

We are working with NWLDC to roll out 'Disc' which is a partnership working CCTV system with Police, Council and local stores working together to reduce offending.

Warrant executed

A drugs warrant was executed at an address on Central Road, Coalville whereby controlled drugs were located and seized at the address. Two males were arrested on suspicion of possession with intent to supply class A.



One of the Coalville Towns beat priorities is tackling shop lifting within the area.

During a day shift Coalville Town Beat Team were made aware of numerous thefts involving identified suspects. The beat team have been busy collecting the CCTV and statements in relation to these reports so we have a strong evidential case. In the evening the eagle-eyed Council CCTV operator spotted the suspects in Coalville and our response officers were quick on the scene to make the arrests.



Joint Agency work with Trading Standards

Officers from the neighbourhood team assisted trading standards with a warrant at a shop in Coalville. After a thorough search, we found a large amount of illegal tobacco & cigarettes stashed in a hide. A good result for both agencies
