You said - We did

- Speeding (10 votes on Neighbourhood Link (NHL)). Between 01/06/2025 and 30/06/2025 the mobile speed camera visited the A4303 Lubenham Hill for a total of 115 minutes. Fifteen offences were detected.
- Anti social behaviour (10 votes on NHL) identifying individuals causing the anti social behaviour. Passing their names to the council to start the incremental approach. Targeting areas of known ASB activity.
- Drug dealing (11 votes on NHL) We have been conducting plain clothes patrols in areas we
 are told drug dealing is an issue. We collect intelligence from residents and CrimeStoppers
 and apply for magistrates warrants and conduct drugs raids on those we suspect of dealing
 in drugs. We encourage anyone to report drug dealing to us anonymously through
 CrimeStoppers.
