


ALERT TRADING STANDARDS Date: 11/08/2025

Please beware of receiving scam texts relating to Winter Heating Allowance such as the one below:



Call 159 using a different phone if you receive a call claiming to be from your bank. This will put you through to your bank's genuine customer service line.

- <u>NEVER</u> open attachments or links in unsolicited emails
- NEVER give out personal information
- <u>DELETE</u> spam emails from your mailbox

Scammers want your name, date of birth & current or previous address to commit identity theft.

With it they can:

- Open bank accounts
- Obtain credit cards/loans & benefits
- Order goods / mobile phone contracts
- Take over existing accounts
- Obtain a passport & driving license
