We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following,

What matters to you

- **Priority 1 - What you have said:**

You have told us that anti-social behaviour (ASB) is a concern in your community, particularly involving the use of quad bikes and groups of rowdy youths gathering in parks and recreational areas.

Action taken

In response, we are increasing patrols in identified hotspots to deter this behaviour and provide reassurance to the public. We are also actively gathering intelligence to identify those responsible and take appropriate action.

- **Priority 2 -**

What you have said:

The community has also stated that speeding and parking issues are a concern at various locations throughout the Charnwood East area.

Action taken

Road safety remains a key concern raised by members of our community, particularly in relation to speeding and parking near schools. In response, we recently conducted a speed enforcement operation on Glebe road in Syston, targeting areas identified through community feedback and local intelligence. Static patrols have also been deployed at a location raised near the traffic lights to monitor driver behaviour and provide a visible deterrent. Further speed operations are planned, and work will continue to address the issues highlighted as a concern.

- **Priority 3 -**

What you have said:

Retail theft has been identified as a growing concern within the beat, with several stores being repeatedly targeted.

Action taken

In response, officers have supported investigations by taking statements and collecting CCTV evidence. We have also liaised with local businesses to strengthen working relationships and improve outcomes when offences occur. Regular patrols have been carried out at key locations, including Thurmaston Retail Park, Tesco in Syston, and Branstons Services, to provide reassurance and deter further incidents.

The Beat Team News

Everyday your local beat team are conducting marked Police car patrols through the villages of Charnwood East. These villages are Syston, Thurmaston, Thrussington, East Goscote, Ratcliffe on the Wreake, Barkby, Barbky Thorpe, Beeby, Rearsby, Hamilton Lea, Queniborough, South Croxton and Thorpebury in the Limes.

Thank you to those who came to our beat engagements this month. Thank you to those for raising their concerns and for all the positive feedback.

On 19/08, PCSO 6024 conducted speed checks along Glebe way in Syston. We want to remind everyone about the serious dangers of speeding. Every time you choose to exceed the speed limit, you put yourself, your passengers, and everyone else on the road at risk.



KEEP YOUR PROPERTY SECURE

- Test your burglar alarm regularly and remember to test it while away
- Close all windows and doors when you're not in the room
- Think about what you post on social media while you're away
- Remember leaving notes for the postman about when to leave parcels
- Fit alarms, sensors and any outbuildings with locks

A 'Fatal 4' operation was conducted at Roundhill School, Thurmaston, with 14 vehicles stopped. The drivers were reported for either mobile phone use whilst driving or not wearing a seatbelt. The term "Fatal 4" refers to four dangerous driving behaviours that frequently contribute to road accidents injuries, and fatalities. Speeding, driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs, Not wearing a seatbelt, using a mobile phone while driving.

On 24/08, PCSO 6098 and 6024 conducted a beat surgery at Thurmaston retail park in Thurmaston. During this beat surgery, we engaged with local residents and listened to their feedback. We appreciate everyone who came out to participate and share their thoughts!



On 23/08, local officers had the wonderful opportunity to attend an event in East Goscote. Throughout the event, officers engaged with families, answered questions and children also had the opportunity to sit in our marked police vehicle.



On 07/08, PCSO 6024 conducted a beat surgery in Syston town square, engaging with local business's and residents. In the evening, PCSO 6098 conducted a beat surgery at East Goscote village hall.

Further investigations and patrols around Thorpebury in the limes have been conducted by the beat team. This is in response to ASB caused by bikes.



On 06/08, PCSO 6024 and PCSO 6098 had the wonderful opportunity to visit Syston Day Nursery. During our visit, we spoke to the children about the important role of the police in keeping our community safe. All the children then had the opportunity to sit in our marked police vehicle! Engaging with young people is always a pleasure and it is a great way to create a positive connection with the police.



The local beat team have been actively patrolling the unoccupied building located on Bridge Park Road in Thurmaston due to reports of youths causing ASB and damage inside.

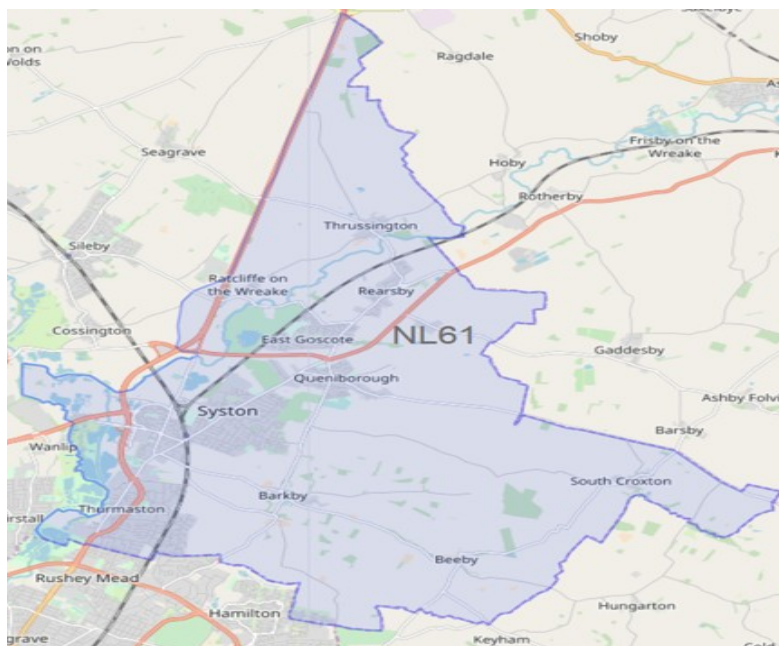
