The stigmatism of talking to the police must end.

When this data used, we can provide partnership interventions to ensure our children are safe. This could be meaningful patrols or talks to our young persons around safety and ensure that their bad experiences don't become the norm for our children.

This isn't meant to replace reporting crime if a young person is a victim of one please still report it to us using the normal channels, but sometimes a behaviour of a person, can make you feel unsafe where it hasn't quite crossed into criminality.
