Dear Ward Member

Please have a read of what the team have been doing.



The team have been busy over the last month maintaining a focus on their ward priorities and taking part in initiatives to help keep the community safe. PC Solanki recently had the opportunity to take part in a live facial recognition operation at Uxbridge Town Centre. This is new technology that is being implemented by the police to target outstanding offenders that require arresting. A burglar was caught during this operation and dealt with accordingly. The team have also teamed up with Ruislip Manor officers and carried out traffic operations targeting drivers who are committing offences. In total eight drivers have been provided with warnings and a traffic offence report has been issued for one driver that contravened a traffic sign. Pro-active patrols are being conducted on the ward especially in areas that are being affected by Anti-social Behaviour and drug related crime. An individual was recently stopped by the team, investigated and dealt with on the spot for being in possession of drugs which were found as a result of a stop and search. The team have also taken part in arrest enquiry operations where they recently assisted Ruislip ward in the arrest of six shoplifters from Waitrose in Ruislip. The team recently conducted their own shoplifting operation where two suspects were caught at Sainsbury's, arrested and charged. The team have continued to carry out weapon sweeps on the ward to identify areas where weapons and articles adapted for use as weapons are being concealed and discarded. The team have maintained their focus on keeping a strong policing presence on the ward and are actively engaging with the community and businesses.
