#YouSaid - What matters to you.

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following in February 2025.

Priority 1: Theft

You said: You told us that you were concerned about thefts, this can include shop thefts and vehicle break ins in the area. We will try to prioritise this going forward.

Priority 2: Motor vehicle crime

You Said: you told us that you were concerned about vehicle crime this includes anything from theft of vehicle to theft from vehicle.

Priority 3: Road Safety

You Said: You have told us that road safety is a priority, this includes speeding, dangerous driving, no insurance, no MOT, no tax and more.

#WeDid - What we are doing

As part of our ongoing priorities in Lutterworth, we have been focusing on thefts, vehicle crime, and road safety.

- **Thefts:** We have carried out targeted patrols around local shops and car parks, identifying and dealing with known offenders. We've also engaged with businesses to provide crime prevention advice and strengthen links with shop staff.
- **Vehicle crime:** We have increased evening patrols in hotspot areas, spoken to residents about simple security steps they can take to secure their property.
- **Road safety:** We have conducted speed checks in areas raised by the community and offered visible reassurance patrols around schools at peak times. We continue to work with partners to highlight the dangers of speeding and inconsiderate parking.

Keeping Our Communities Safe

As we move into September, the Lutterworth Beat Team would like to share an update on some of the work carried out during August to support and protect our local communities.

Reassurance Patrols and Crime Prevention

Following reports of vehicle crime and burglaries across the beat area, **PCSO 6063** has been out visiting residents to provide reassurance, offer crime prevention advice, and discuss measures that can help keep homes and vehicles secure.

PCSO 6063 also assisted with road closures in **Cotesbach** following a road traffic collision, helping to ensure the safety of motorists and local residents while emergency services carried out their duties.

Tackling Shop Theft

The team has completed a number of **CCTV enquiries** in relation to shop theft offences reported across the beat area. These enquiries have helped to support ongoing investigations and identify offenders.

We are also pleased to report that **prolific shoplifter Michael Church** was arrested, charged, and remanded to court following offences committed within the local area.

Addressing Anti-Social Behaviour

The Beat Team has continued to carry out **targeted patrols in anti-social behaviour hotspots** identified by members of the community. These patrols have provided a visible police presence, engaged with local residents, and helped address concerns raised through neighbourhood meetings and reports.

Beat Office Drop-In Sessions

Following feedback from residents about making neighbourhood officers more accessible, the Beat Team is pleased to announce that the **Beat Office at the Pavilion, Coventry Road Recreation Ground, Lutterworth**, will now be open for **weekly drop-in sessions for one hour each week**.

These sessions will provide an opportunity for residents to discuss concerns, seek advice, report issues, and meet members of their local policing team in person. Details of weekly opening times will be shared through our social media channels.

Vehicle Seized for Multiple Offences

On **16 August 2026**, local PCSOs seized a vehicle after it was found to have:

- No insurance
- No vehicle tax
- No valid MOT

This serves as a reminder to all motorists to ensure their vehicles are legally compliant and that all documentation is kept up to date before driving on public roads.

On **24 August 2026**, members of the Beat Team carried out **speed checks on Brookfield Way, Lutterworth**. Road safety remains a priority, and these checks help address concerns raised by residents regarding speeding vehicles in the area.

Supporting Community Events

The event welcomed large numbers of visitors, and officers worked closely with organisers to help ensure the festival was safe and enjoyable for everyone attending.
