## You said - We did

- Speeding (34 votes on Neighbourhood Link (NHL)) . Between 01/12/2025 and 31/12/2025 the mobile speed camera visited the A47 four times, Kibworth A6 once, and Newton Harcourt once. In total seven offences were detected.
- Anti social behaviour (21 votes on NHL) - identifying individuals causing the anti social behaviour. Passing their names to the council to start the incremental approach. Targeting areas of known ASB activity.
- Nuisance motorbikes (19 votes on NHL) - We have been conducting uniformed and marked vehicle patrols in the areas you have told us this is a problem. We have directed officers to these areas in any down time they have to deter these offenders from causing problems in these areas.



Over a two week period, local officers stopped a number of cars and dealt with the drivers for traffic offences. On one night shift, officers stopped a car driving in Market Harborough with the incorrect licence and therefore no insurance. The driver was issued a ticket, and the car was seized.

Checks showed his passenger was wanted for offences in Northants so was arrested and taken to Northants custody.

Another stop revealed a vehicle whose driver had no insurance. They were issued a ticket, and the car was seized. A further stop found a driver with no insurance who tested positive for drugs, so was arrested and taken to custody.
