#YouSaid - What matters to you

Through Neighbourhood Link, social media and local engagement events, we have listened and will be prioritising the following -

You said - ASB within Belvoir Centre and wider town centre.

We Will – We have completed a number of operations within the town centre and are holding frequent meetings with security personnel and colleagues in our CCTV office. We have identified a number of those causing harm and have actions in place which we continue to monitor. Our work with partners is on-going to continue to engage with our young persons and to provide provisions to detract from behaviour which causes distress to others. We are continuing with this work and as such this priority will continue in to the next quarter.

You Said – You have raised concerns relating to road safety, specifically surrounding our local Primary Schools. This includes driving at excess speed for the location, inappropriate road use and dangerous parking.

We Will – We will work with local schools and agencies to seek long term solutions. We will engage with road safety teams in order to offer education and will carry out enforcement where appropriate. We will hold speed checks and carry out frequent patrols at the relevant times.

You Said – We have had issues associated with youths purchasing alcohol and vapes at local retailers raised to us. These being underage and illegally sold.

We Will – We have conducted a test purchase operation in the town centre which also raised concerns. As a result we will target this area, completing further operations and working with colleagues in licensing to ensure out town centre is safe and legal.
