What matters to you

From information collated from local surveys, beat knowledge, intelligence and reports to Leicestershire Police, the following areas have been highlighted as priorities within the community:

- **Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)**

You said: Anti-social behaviour in the area of Wigston Lane.

We did: This month the team have worked to patrol the area of Wigston Lane, this is to deter criminality and develop any further intelligence. The team have been able to speak with local residents about and issues/concerns which in turn has supported us in focusing our patrols/resources better.

- **Priority 2: Drugs**

You said: Drug dealing in various locations across Aylestone

We did: We have had multiple stop searches around parts of Aylestone, this is due to intelligence surrounding drug misuse. This has helped us identify parts of Aylestone which are more likely to be used for this type of behaviour. This is a working progress for the team and will continue to use our resources to deter this.

We did: This is a brand new priority for the team. Come back next month for an update on what progress we have made.

- **Priority 3: Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)**

You said: Anti-Social behaviour in the area of Montrose Road South

We did: Due to an increase in Anti-social Behaviour, the team have been able to identify suspects and issue warnings. These warnings are a deterrent to further behaviour, however, if this behaviour continues we are able to then issue acceptable behaviour contracts (ABC's) and other relevant out of court disposals. We have had positive results so far, we will continue to work towards resolving these issues.

Some positive action has been taken and suspects of this have been identified, written warnings being issued which has started to build a foundation for zero tolerance of this behaviour. Work is still being completed to resolve this.
