## Alcester Police SNTs. Latest Weekly Report. Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2026

*Based at Alcester Police Station, The Safer Neighbourhood team's primary roles are around crime prevention, problem solving both long standing or emerging issues of community concern and community engagement. We are supported at Alcester by colleagues from Patrol teams whose role is to respond to incidents and investigate crimes that occur in the area 24/7. The SNT is supervised by Inspector Jake Kibblewhite who leads on Neighbourhood Policing for Stratford District and Sgt Ebbs who also oversees neighbourhood Policing in the Shipston on Stour area. The Alcester SNT currently consists of 2 Police officers and 5 Police Community Support Officers, and our contact details are shown above.*

### **Twelve motorists arrested for drink or drug driving offences.**

Over the past six days, twelve motorists have been arrested for drink or drug driving offences - four following crashes. The highest roadside reading came from a 47-year-old Atherstone man who blew 108 micrograms of alcohol per 100ml of breath – more than three times the legal limit, after a Boxing Day collision in Dordon. He's been charged and will appear in court on 14 January.

Other arrests include:

- A 23-year-old provisional driver from Leicester stopped on the A46 near Warwick. He had no L plates or supervision and tested positive for cannabis.
- A 46-year-old Alcester man arrested after stealing a turkey and driving off with a beer in his van.
- A 48-year-old Rugby man who crashed into a parked car and tried to avoid arrest by asking the owner not to call the police. He blew 99 at the roadside.

They have all been bailed. Inspector Wayne Boulton said "Drink or drug driving puts lives at risk and will not be tolerated. We're stepping up patrols to catch offenders and prevent serious collisions. Please plan ahead this New Year's Eve – book a taxi, go out locally, or choose alcohol-free options. There really is no excuse." - issued 31<sup>st</sup> December.

## **14-year-old boy charged in connection with multiple burglaries**

A rapid response to multiple reports of burglaries has seen a 14-year-old boy charged in connection with eight offences. On the 1st of January, we began to receive reports of burglaries in the Leamington and Warwick area, starting at around 5am. The first report came from a shop – with the next three being reports of homes being targeted. One of the burglaries reportedly saw a Ford focus stolen and traffic officers, armed response and dog units worked with patrol officers and CCTV operators to track it. We found it on the A46, and it was forcefully stopped, with a male occupant being arrested. A 14-year-old boy from Warwick, who cannot be named because of his age, has subsequently been charged with:

- Three burglaries of dwellings
- One burglary of a non-dwelling
- Theft of a motor vehicle
- Dangerous driving
- Driving without insurance
- Driving whilst disqualified (driving bans can be given to under 16s, with the ban formally coming into effect when they are old enough to hold a licence. When under 16, it serves as an aggravating factor should they drive.)

He has been bailed with strict conditions and will appear before youth court in Coventry on Thursday, 8 January. Officers will be attending the relevant address over the next week to ensure bail conditions are being complied with. We thank the community for reporting yesterday's incidents so quickly.
