

Brunswick and Adelaide PCSO Monthly Update

Hi all!

This is your current ward update for Brunswick and Adelaide, looking back at the month just gone, and offering current crime prevention advice.

Within the month of February:

- Reports of ASB increased to 42 reports. Two of these reports related to being drunk and disorderly.
- There was 1 report of burglary in February.
- There were 8 reports of criminal damage in January.



Patrols:

There were 11 patrols within the month of February. The average patrol time was just over 40 minutes.

I spent a morning with a colleague from the Business Crime Reduction Partnership speaking to businesses around the ward area, offering crime prevention advice and encouraging reporting of crime and ASB.

Specifics:

- 1 report of bicycle theft on Palmeira Avenue
- 1 report of vehicle crime on York Road
- 1 report of youth ASB on Western Road



Key Priorities:

- To see more patrols in hotspot areas such as the green spaces, Waterloo Street gardens and surrounding roads, and along the general thoroughfare of Western Road.
