We have been in touch with the shops that are being targeted and given advice on reporting and speaking to us. If it is not reported we don't know about it, so please report to us!

We encourage all residents to report suspicious activity, no matter how small — every report helps us build a clearer picture and direct resources effectively.

Current Ward Priorities

- **Shoplifting** – We're working with local businesses to address persistent incidents
- **Anti-social behaviour & drug-related activity** – Regular patrols continue in known hotspots
