Policing Activity & Results

Across officers from all policing teams, there has been **236 stop and searches** conducted and **302 arrests** made. These actions have played an important part in tackling crime, disrupting offending, and preventing harm across the area. Every officer involved - whether from Response, the Safer Neighbourhoods Team, Specialist Units, or wider borough policing - has contributed to these outcomes. We're proud of the professionalism and dedication shown daily by our teams. These collective efforts help keep our community safer and reinforce our commitment to visible, proactive, and fair policing.

Your Reports Make a Real Difference

One of the most important tools we have is you - our community. Reporting incidents, concerns, or suspicious behaviour ensures issues are known borough-wide, not just to the Safer Neighbourhood Team. When reports are made through proper channels, they are shared across policing teams, enabling:

Faster and more effective responses.
Better intelligence.
Stronger long-term problem solving.
Targeted patrols where they're actually needed.

If something doesn't feel right, please report it. Even small pieces of information can help build a bigger picture, support ongoing investigations, and ultimately prevent crime.
