## What matters to you

You told us these 3 issues are most important to you:

#### 1. Drug Dealing

What we're doing:

We're working with local people to find out where drug dealing is happening. Our team is focused on stopping those involved. We are also teaming up with other organisations to take strong action including possible closure orders at certain addresses

#### 2. Shoplifting

What we're doing:

We're helping shops report thefts quickly and gather the right evidence. This helps us catch repeat offenders faster. We're also encouraging stores to share information with each other to help prevent more thefts.

### 3. Road Safety and Speeding

What we're doing:

We've carried out speed checks in Anson Road, Shepshed, and Shepshed Road, Hathern—based on what you told us. We're working to stop speeding, raise awareness, and make roads safer for everyone.

### **Community Engagement**

The team conduct regular beat surgeries at various venues across the beat area to engage with the community, address concerns, and provide support.
