Road Safety including car cruising, anti-social driving and vehicle safety has been highlighted by the public as an issue. 	We take road safety very seriously but unfortunately we can't be everywhere all the time. We can however deal with drivers at a later stage when video evidence is provided. This was the case this month when a white van was seen swerving, stopping and starting and narrowly missing other cars on Countesthorpe Road, Cosby. Our witness luckily had a camera onboard and recorded this. The footage was sent to our Collision Support Unit where this will be followed up.

News

Earlier today, PC Jodie and PCSO Calum joined response officers PC Cooper and Sgt Wood who attended reports of suspected badger baiting near Mill Lane, Blaby. Thanks to the vigilance of a member of the public and police action:

Two individuals were located and searched under the Badger Act. The activity was confirmed as poaching other animals and will be dealt with by our Rural Crime Team. All animals that had been caught were safely released back into the wild. Intelligence will be submitted along side crime reports. Whilst rural crime in Blaby is rare we take it seriously and will continue working to protect our countryside and its animals. Numerous calls were received over youths throwing fireworks around Winchester Road and Lutterworth Road in Blaby as well as Enderby Road in Whetstone. Officers attended the location and Ring Doorbell footage was received, unfortunately at this time we have been unable to identify the perpetrators.

A number of burglaries and attempted burglaries have occurred on the beat last month, as much as I'd like to update you, these are all being dealt with by CID and the investigation is very much still live. CCTV, forensics, ANPR and intelligence and being looked at and the investigations continue.

As well as making your home look occupied, there are some quick and easy steps you can take to prevent opportunistic thieves from entering your home. Keep doors and windows locked and take the key out of the lock. Prevent easy access to your home with locked gates or fencing. Move/remove items which can provide easier access to windows, such as bins and garden furniture. Burglars are known to use ladders to access upper windows to avoid intruder alarm sensors on the lower floors of properties. Keep ladders out of sight and ensure sheds, garages and outbuildings are locked.
