What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will priorities the following from March 2025.

Priority 1: ASB. You said: You have concerns around antisocial behavior across the village. We will continue to try and disrupt this type of behavior and use the ASB incremental approach to deter offenders.

Priority 2: Speeding. You said: You are concerned about vehicles speeding in the villages. We will continue to monitor and enforce speed across several sites in the village.

Priority 3: Burglaries. We aim to work with the relevant authorities to reduce the burglaries across the village and to try and reduce the number of reported thefts from the recycling centre. Visiting victims and offering crime prevention advice.

Priority 1: The beat team aim to tackle different elements of ASB in Mountsorrel

We have dealt with a small number of ASB-related reports this month:

As highlighted in a recent weekly update, we received a report of an off-road motorbike in the Castle Hill area. This currently appears to be an isolated incident, but we will continue to monitor the location.

This week, we have received reports from the Halstead Road area, particularly near the park, of objects believed to be eggs thrown at passing vehicles.

Investigations are ongoing as we work to identify those involved.

Patrols in the area have been increased, and we urge anyone with information or CCTV footage to contact us.

ASB can have a big impact on the community, and we are committed to addressing it quickly and effectively.

If you witness any similar behaviour or ongoing ASB, please report it via 101 so it can be dealt with promptly.

Priority 2: The beat team aim to target reports of speeding in Mountsorrel.

Speed Ops

There have been no speed operations conducted this month.

However, the team will be looking to reconvene speed checks next month to address ongoing concerns reported by residents.

If you have suggestions for specific locations where speeding is a problem, please let us know.

We will continue to respond to speeding concerns where they are raised and carry out checks where appropriate.

Priority 3: Burglaries

This month, there have been three burglaries, which is an increase from last month. In response:

High-visibility patrols will continue in key areas to provide reassurance and deter offenders.

Crime prevention visits will be offered by the beat team whenever a burglary occurs.

We encourage residents to remain vigilant and report any suspicious activity immediately via 101 or online.

Simple steps such as keeping doors and windows locked, using timers for lights, and ensuring sheds/outbuildings are secure can make a significant difference.
