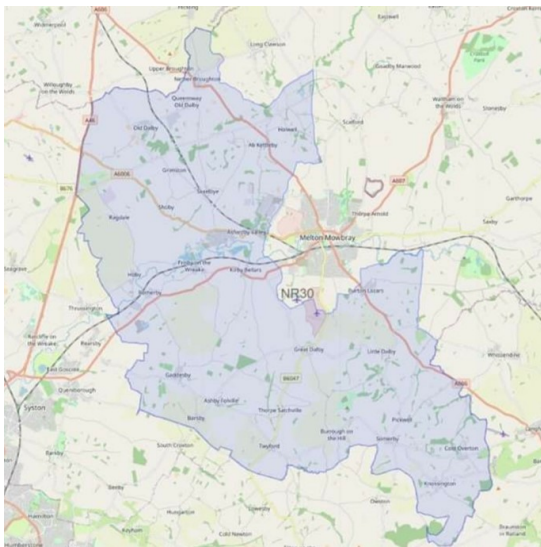

July crime and incident statistics

Here are details of incidents on the beat over the last month:

Thefts – 2

Burglaries – 2

Criminal damage – 2

Assault (including domestic related assault) – 10

Road Traffic Collisions / Road Traffic incidents – 38

Again this month the acquisitive crime figures are low as are rural crime figures; but you will notice that there has been a higher demand on your local police in relation to incidents on the road network.
