Based at Alcester Police Station, The Safer Neighbourhood team's primary roles are around crime prevention, problem solving both long standing or emerging issues of community concern and community engagement. We are supported at Alcester by colleagues from Patrol teams whose role is to respond to incidents and investigate crimes that occur in the area 24/7. The SNT is supervised by Inspector Jake Kibblewhite who leads on Neighbourhood Policing for Stratford District and Sgt Ebbs who also oversees neighbourhood Policing in the Shipston on Stour area. The Alcester SNT currently consists of 2 Police officers and 5 Police Community Support Officers, and our contact details are shown above.

Man arrested after pre-planned policing operation.

Detectives from Counter Terrorism Policing West Midlands have (Tuesday 16 September) arrested a man in a pre-planned policing operation.

The 28-year-old was detained from an address in West Warwickshire on suspicion of using, publishing, or distributing material with the intent to stir up racial hatred.

He is currently in custody for questioning.

Parents urged to get their child car seats checked.

We are encouraging parents and carers to take the opportunity to ensure their child car seat is safe and legal at one of the free child car seat check events being held across Warwickshire next week.

The advice comes after one of our SNT officers discovered an illegal and dangerous child car seat was being used in a car in Rugby. The officer reported the illegal seat to WHICH? who have issued this warning in the news today. Return of 'killer car seats' - fabric seats spotted at checking event - Which?

PC Rachel Wonfor said "It's really important that parents and carers of children get advice and guidance on choosing the correct car seat for their child. The illegal child car seat pictured had been purchased unknowingly online and would offer a child no protection in the event of a crash. Fortunately, we spotted this and were able to help the parent ensure their children travelled safely by giving them the help and advice they needed. "

Most parents and carers would be horrified and upset to know that not providing a child car seat for a child until they're 12 years old or 135 centimetres tall, whichever comes first could result in a fine.

You can have your child car seat checked for free by Warwickshire Road Safety Partnership at the following locations between 10am and 3pm:

Monday 22 Sept - Stratford Leisure Centre

Tuesday 23 Sept – Asda Leamington

Wednesday 24 Sept – Asda Rugby

Thursday 25 Sept – Tesco Atherstone

Friday 26 Sept – Asda Nuneaton
