There have been a number of thefts from motor vehicles in this area.

Keep your vehicle safe:

- Keep doors locked and do not leave windows open.
- Do not leave any valuables on display.
- Remove sat navs from display and wipe the mark from the window where it has been secured.
- MP3's ipads, iphones etc. take them with you.
- If you intend to leave items in the vehicle place them in the boot and not in the glove box or under the seat.
- Put away any charging cables from the cigarette lighter and put the lighter back in it's place.
- Remove stereo fascia if possible.
- Leave the glove box open and sun visors down to show there is nothing hidden.
- Don't leave any bags or clothing or loose change on display.

All of the above points were identified by a known criminal as to what he looks for when breaking into a vehicle.
