3 MONTH PRIORITIES: (Month 2)

What matters to you?

PARKING

Police have been told by residents that they are concerned about poor parking.

Parking is generally a council issue, but we accept we can play a part in improving the safety of the roads on our beat.

ASB: VEHICLES:

Over the winter period the beat team have received reports of vehicle related ASB – specifically persons smoking drugs in their cars with their friends and playing music late at night causing distress to residents in the area.

TOWER BLOCKS:

Our colleagues at the City Council, and residents of the four tower blocks on the beat, have raised concerns over the amount of people who are managing to enter the locations, sleep in the stairwells, harass residents and take drugs.

What we are doing

PARKING:

We are keeping this as an NPA priority, and we are still working on achieving the overall objective of reducing the poor parking that is consistently seen around the Spinney Hill area. Your beat team have charged a person for two assaults that occurred during a disagreement over a disabled parking bay and issued two out of court disposals for another similar matter.





What we are doing cont'd...

ASB: VEHICLES:

Your beat team have already begun tackling this problem. We will be sharing on social media posts about how the public can report these issues, what Police can deal with specifically and continue to do what we can to deter the problem.

TOWER BLOCKS:


Your police team will be working with the council to provide guidance on how they can prevent persons accessing the buildings. We will also be patrolling the area to deal with people causing ASB.
