#YouSaid - What matters to you

Through Neighbourhood Link, social media and local engagement events, we have listened and will be prioritising:

- **Drug dealing and associated ASB on Kane Close.**

You have raised concerns regarding drug use and the anti-social behaviour associated with this type of criminality.

We have received a number of reports relating to issues surrounding drug use in this area. We have completed a warrant and will continue to work with partners to seek long term solutions.

- **ASB in Coalville Town Centre**

We are aware of continued issues with young people causing general ASB after local football matches.

We are working with local residents, management at the club and partners in problem solving teams to develop long term solutions.

- **Speeding/Nuisance vehicles Ashby Road/London Road.**

We are aware of issues surrounding ongoing issues with inconsiderate and antisocial road use.

We will complete targeted operations in the areas concerned and look to offer education and enforcement where required. We have completed a number of enforcements and have more planned.

#WeDid - What we are doing

Joint Operation with the Home Office

Coalville have teamed up with Home Office Immigration staff, the Gangmasters Labour & Abuse Authority as well as our own Modern Slavery team to conduct a joint operation. During this we carried out visits at locations across North West Leicestershire to complete immigration status checks and to ensure working conditions were acceptable and the employees were not being exploited. The operation was successful with employers engaging well and no concerns being identified for their employees. One site proved a little more eventful, however, with a male being identified as working in breach of his home office visa conditions. He is now being appropriately dealt with by the Home Office Immigration team.



Successful Shift for the Safer Streets Team

A successful last shift before well earned rest days for the local NPT, local DNO's and Safer Streets Team as they were looking for wanted people and suspicious activity. A wanted male who was outstanding for shop theft whilst we were conducting licensing checks in Coalville town. The teams also targeted a vehicle of interest which resulted in the arrest of one male for numerous theft offences and being wanted on a recall to prison, we also seized the vehicle for having no valid insurance and the driver was dealt with accordingly.
